- Legislation/Public Policy: Interns will work on the Senator's policy initiatives as well as draft memoranda and analyze pending legislation for both floor votes as well as committee hearings.
- Communications/Media: Interns will draft and edit press releases, statements, social media posts, official correspondence and other forms of communications in a variety of forums of media.
- Community/Public Relations: Interns will help liaise between various community organizations and the Senator's office and assist in planning event and helping serve the community's needs.
- Government Services/Casework: Interns will assist constituents in resolving various government-related issues and obtaining services in an array of areas.
